#### **RESOLUTION NO. 2020-087**

Scheduling a Public Hearing and Directing Notice Thereof for the Consideration of the Legalization of a Portion of NW Rocky Point Road, County Road No. 445.

## **The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Finds:**

- a. NW Rocky Point Road was establish as County Road No. 445 in 1888 and for portions of said road, between Engineer's Stations 75+91.54 and 84+40.70, the road as traveled and used for at least the past ten years does not conform to the existing records for this county road.
- b. On June 25, 2020, the Board of Commissioners adopted Resolution No. 2020-055, initiating proceedings for the legalization of this portion of NW Rocky Point Road and directed the County Surveyor to conduct a survey of the road, pursuant to ORS 368.201 to 368.221.
- c. As required under ORS 368.206(1), the County Surveyor has completed the survey of the road, attached here as Exhibit A, and prepared a report to the Board with the proposed new County Road Number "5031".
- d. The above referenced statutes require the County to hold a public hearing to consider legalization of NW Rocky Point Road, and provide notice thereof by service to the abutting property owners and by posting pursuant to ORS 368.206(1)(c).

## **The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Resolves:**

- 1. The Board of County Commissioner will hold a hearing on Thursday, December 10, 2020 at 9:30 am. Due to ongoing Covid-19 pandemic, Board meetings are being held virtually and are accessible to the public via telephone or electronic device. Information about providing testimony and obtaining access can be found at https://multco.us/multnomah-county/about-board-meetings.
- 2. The purpose of the hearing is to determine whether the legalization of a portion of NW Rocky Point Road, as County Road No. 5031, is in the public's interest. The hearing will concern NW Rocky Point Road from Engineer's Station 75+91.54 to Engineer's Station 84+40.70
- 3. The County Surveyor is directed to provide notice of the hearing to abutting property owners by service and by posting in a manner consistent with ORS 368.401 to 368.426.
