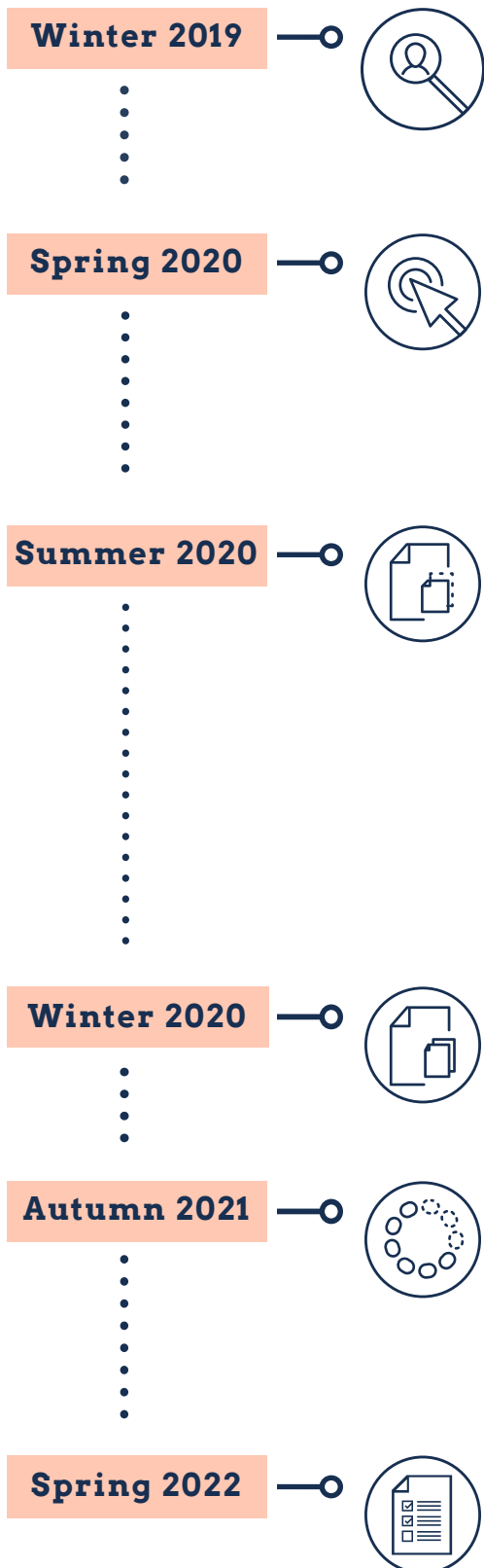


# ACHP Provider Rule Review Committee Summary

A main goal of this revision is to make the MCARs more user-friendly both in organization and readability.



## DEVELOPMENT

- ✔ Adult Care Home operators and managers are invited to participate in the review of the current Multnomah County Administrative Rules (MCARs) for Adult Care Homes.

## COVID-19 PANDEMIC

- ✔ Provider Rule Review Committee meets: approves charter and votes on sections of the MCARs that the committee will address.
- ✔ The committee decides to review seven parts of the current MCARs.
- ✔ The pandemic spreads in Oregon. Committee meetings placed on hold.

## COMMITTEE RESTARTS

- ✔ Provider Rule Review Committee begins remote/virtual meetings.
- ✔ Committee reviews:
  - Part IV: Licensing and Applications
  - Part VII: Standards For Operators, Resident Managers, Shift Managers, and Caregivers
  - Part IX: Standards for Operation
  - Part X: Standards for Adult Care Homes
  - Part XI: Adult Care Home Rules for ADVSD Homes
  - Part XII: Adult Care Homes Rules for DDS Homes
  - Part XIV: Abuse, Neglect and Exploitation

## COMMITTEE REVIEW

- ✔ The Provider Rule Review Committee completes its review of the current MCARs.

## ACHP REVIEW

- ✔ The Multnomah County Adult Care Home Program reviews the current MCARs for needed updates and revisions.
- ✔ The Multnomah County Adult Care Home Program writes proposed revision of the MCARs incorporating committee and ACHP feedback.

## PUBLIC COMMENT

- ✔ Proposed rules will be released spring 2022.
- ✔ Notice of Proposed Rulemaking sent.
- ✔ Rules Advisory Committee (RAC) formed.
- ✔ Public comment period on proposed MCARs
