## **Community Involvement Committee Team Agreements 2020-2021**

- Use both/and thinking
  - Recognize the limits (and gifts) of our lived experience: my lens is but one way of seeing and being in the world, that does not make it right, and it makes it critical to our collective knowing
  - Take healthy risks: Move up, Be wrong, Practice vulnerability
  - Practice reciprocity: Moving from “me” to “we” and prioritizing “us” over “I”
  - Be accountable: For your actions, For your unearned privilege, for repair of harm you have caused
  - Honor confidentiality - what is said here stays, what is learned leaves
