

Public Charge: What you need to know

Beginning Oct. 15, 2019, a new federal rule will impact all immigrant communities who use SNAP (food stamp) benefits, Federal Public Housing and Section 8 assistance, non-emergency Medicaid for non-pregnant adults and cash assistance programs (SSI, TANF, General Assistance).

New rules are not in effect yet.

The new immigration rules will not be used until Oct. 15 and may change with further legal challenges.

- If your child is a U.S. citizen, public programs they use will not be held against you.
