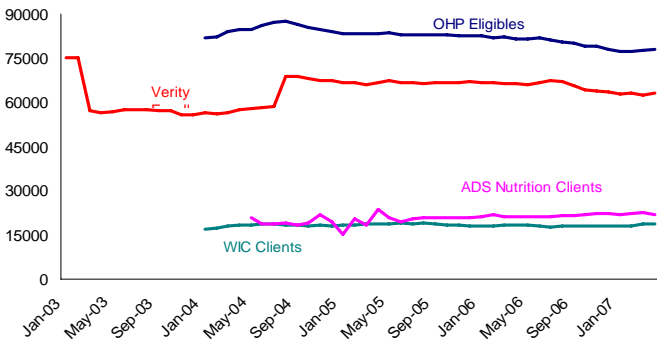

Multnomah County Basic Needs Clients

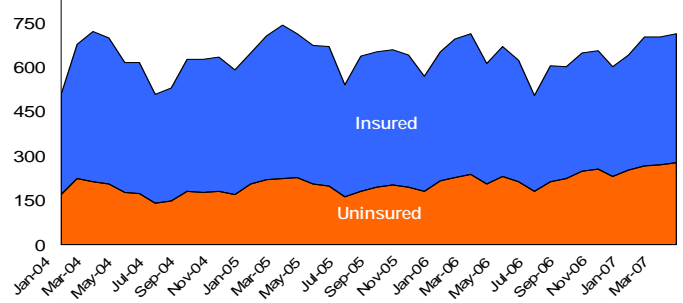
Clients Enrolled or Served by Basic Needs Programs

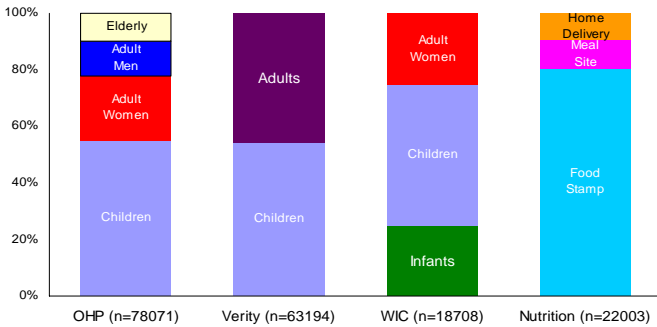
Multnomah County Health Clinic Visits

Average Daily Health Dept. Clinic Visits by Payer Mix

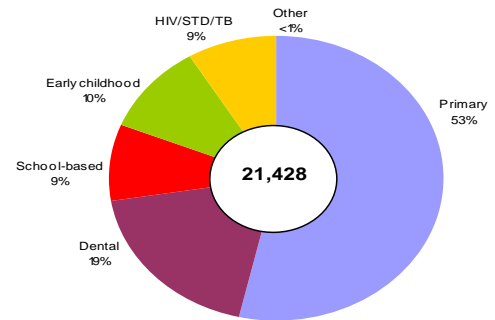


*April 2007 had a total of 714 average daily visits. Of those, 61% were insured and 39% were not insured.

Clients in Basic Needs Programs: April 2007



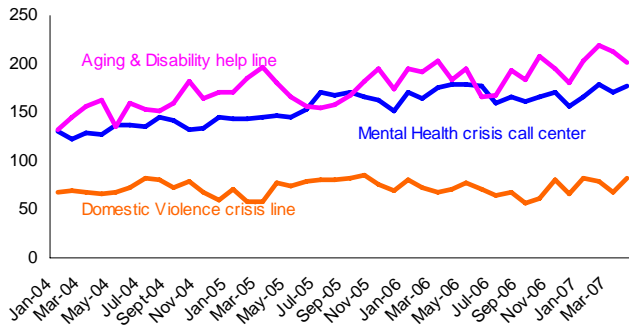
Type of MCHD Clinic Visits: April 2007

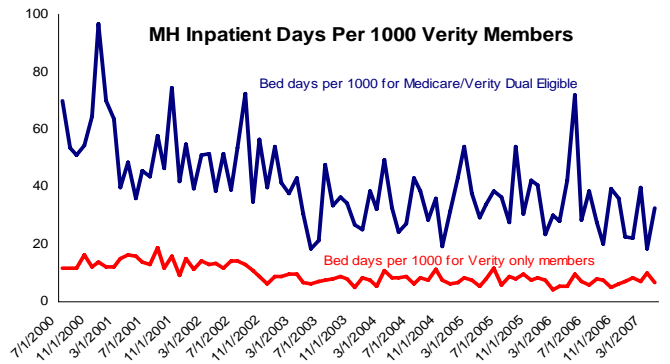
Crisis Center & Helpline Calls

Average Daily ADS, MH, & DV Help Line Calls



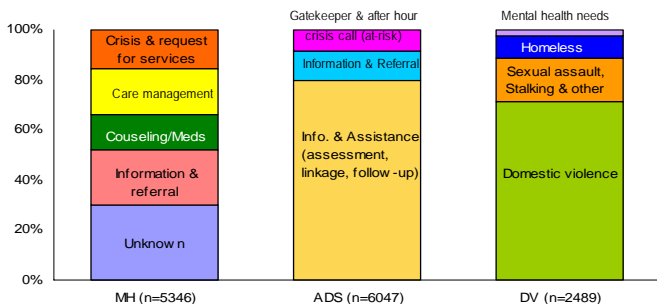
Mental Health Verity Inpatient Days

MH Inpatient Days Per 1000 Verity Members

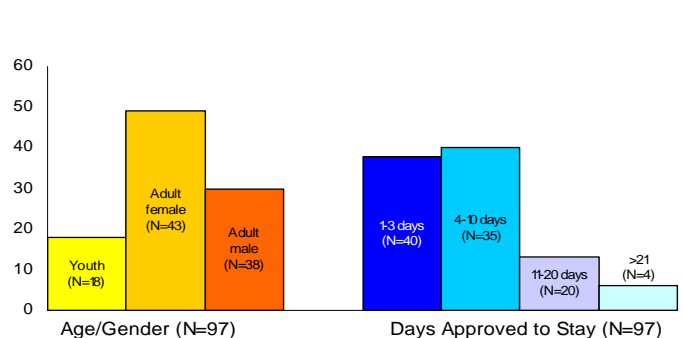


The County pays an average of \$4,200 per discharge for each Verity only inpatient stay and \$1,100 for Medicare/Verity dual eligibles. The April average length of stay per discharge is 7.22 days.

Crisis Help Line Call Or Response Type: April 2007



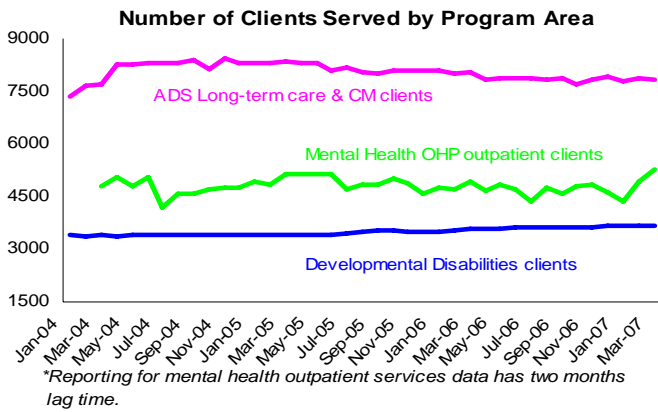
Verity Inpatient Admission/Discharge Profile: April 2007



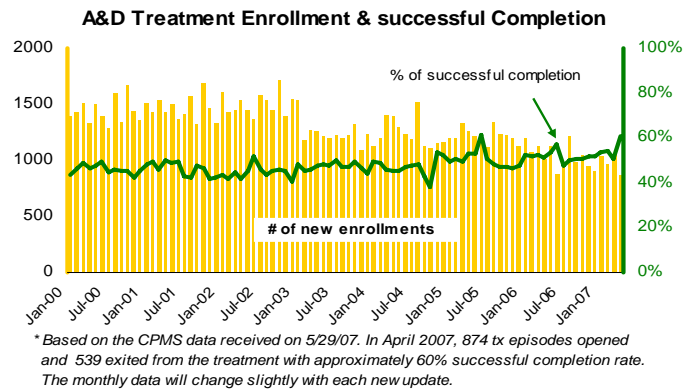
* The 355 paid bed days in April 2007 represent a total of 97 hospital discharges.

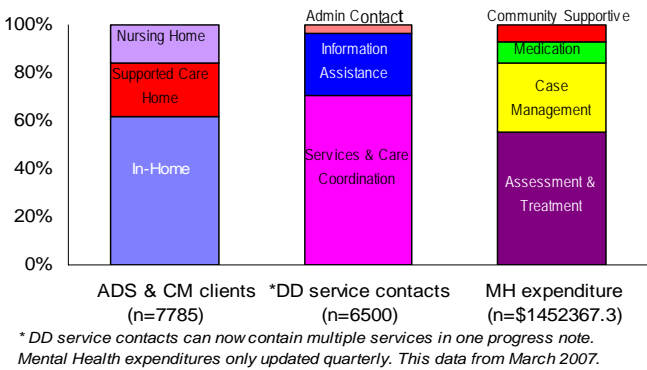

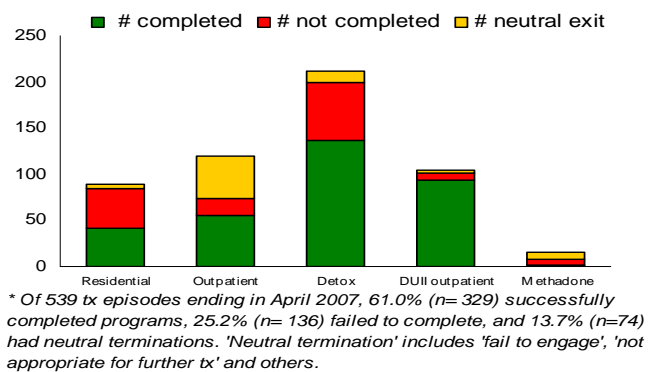
Multnomah County Addictions Treatment



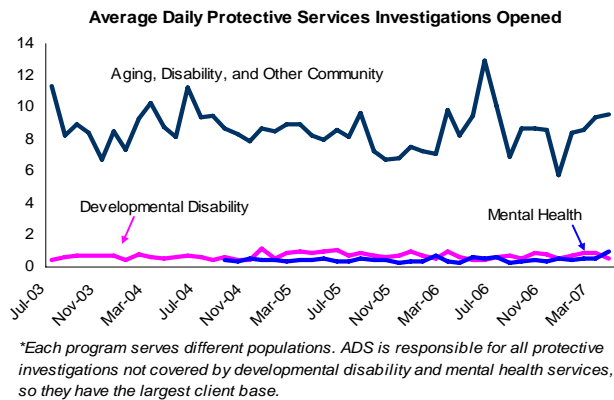
Client or Service Type: April 2007



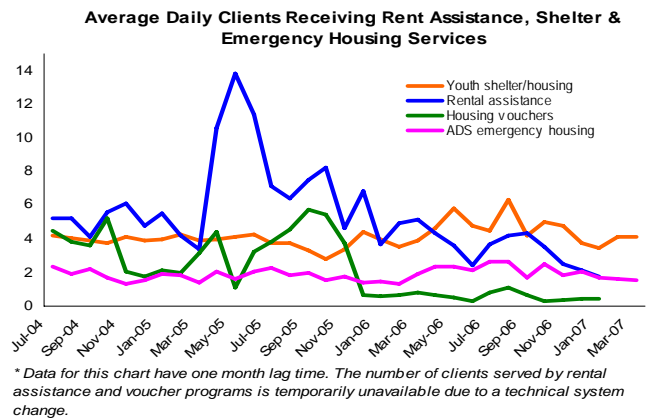
A&D Treatment Exit Type by Modality: April 2007



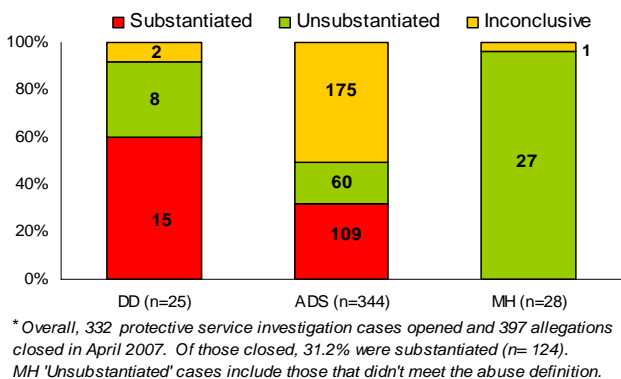
Protective Services for Vulnerable Populations



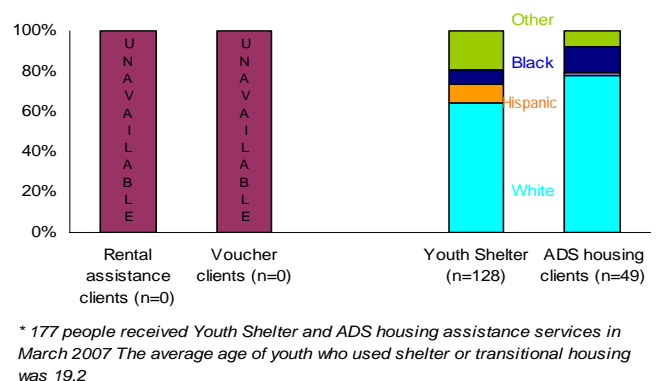
Shelter & Emergency Housing Assistance

Notes: There were significantly more Developmental Disability (DD) and Mental Health (MH) cases closed in April compared to March. Number of cases for DD almost doubled (from 14 to 25) while number of cases for MH more than doubled (from 12 to 28).
