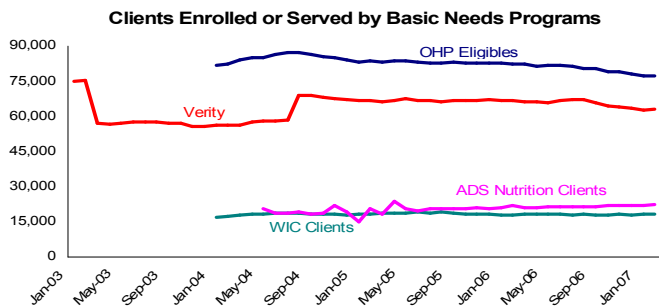


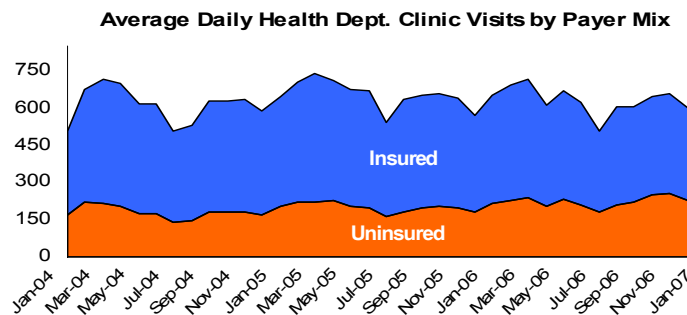

## Multnomah County Basic Needs Clients



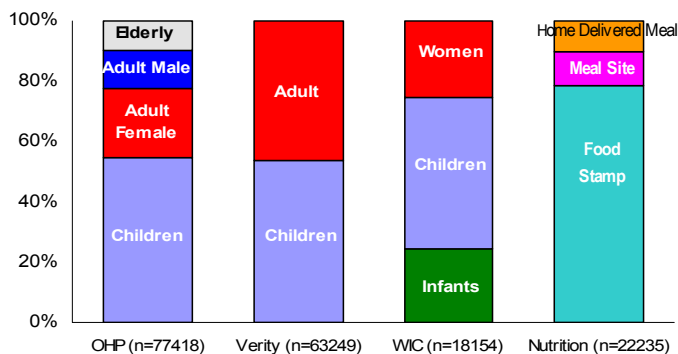
\* Participation in OHP, Verity, WIC, and ADS nutrition service programs can be overlapped.

## Multnomah County Health Clinic Visits

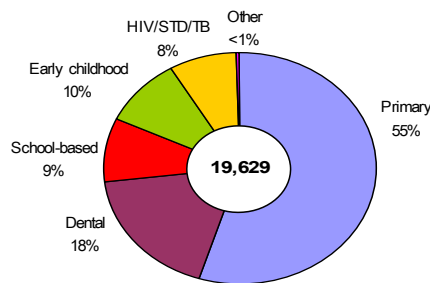


\* February 2007 had a total of 701 average daily visits. Of those, 62% were insured and 38% were not insured.

## Clients in Basic Needs Programs: February 2007

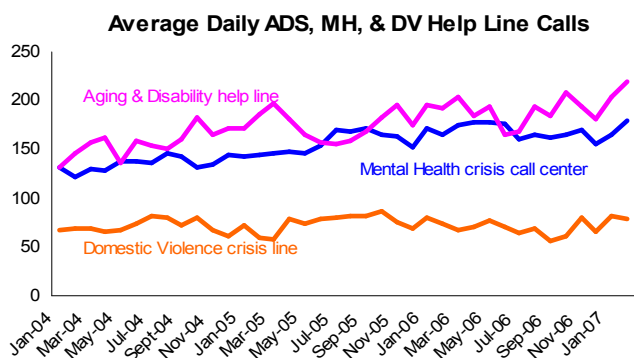


## Type of MCHD Clinic Visits: February 2007

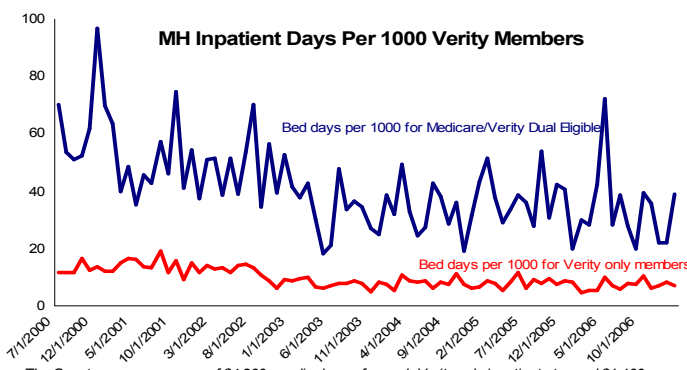

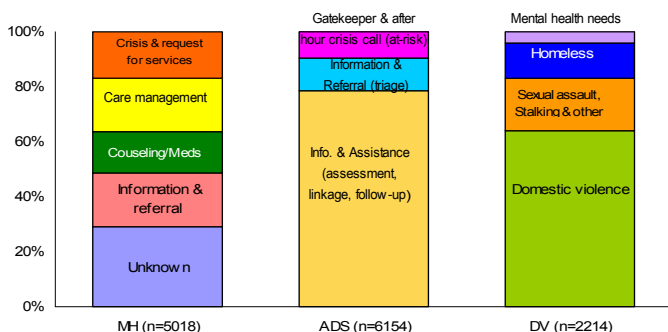


## Mental Health Verity Inpatient Days

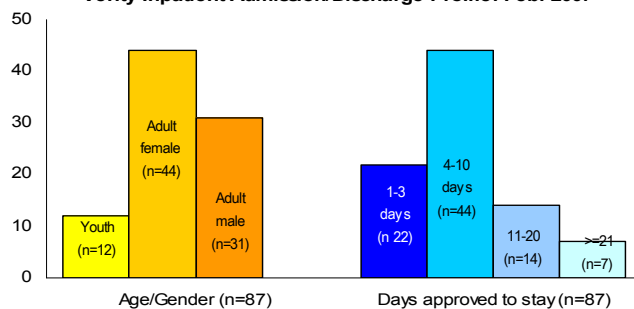


The County pays an average of \$4,200 per discharge for each Verity only inpatient stay and \$1,100 for Medicare/Verity dual eligibles. The February overall average length of stay per discharge is 8.89 days.

## Crisis Help Line Call Or Response Type: February 2007



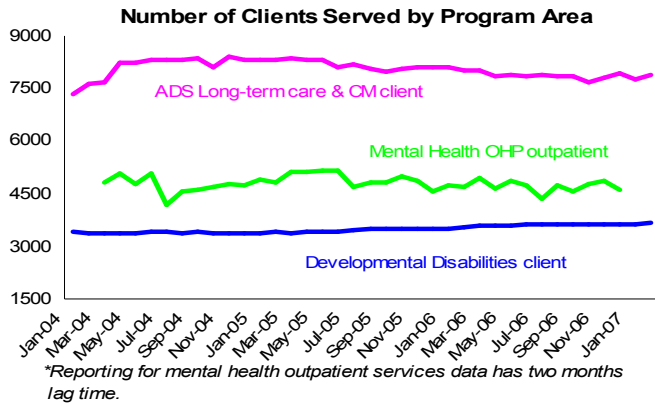
## Verity Inpatient Admission/Discharge Profile: Feb. 2007



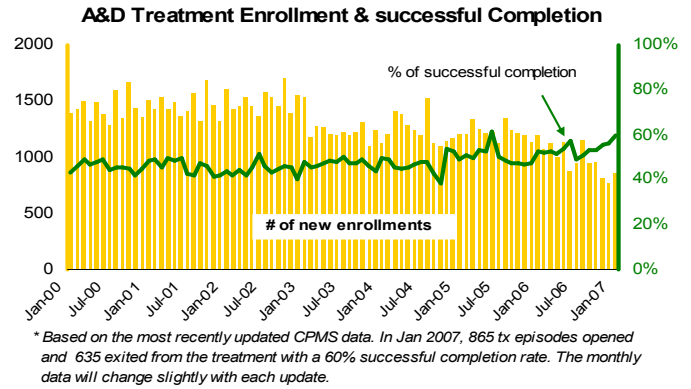
\* The paid bed days in Feb 2007 represent a total of 87 hospital discharges.

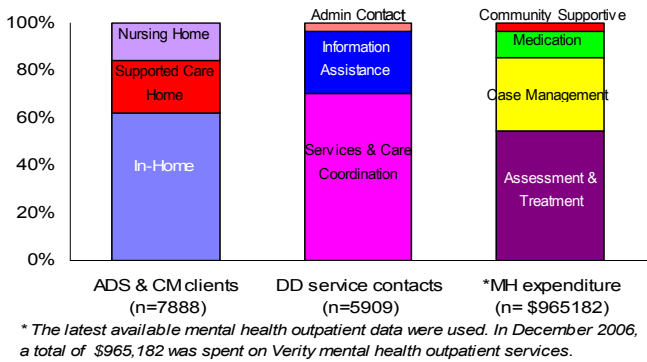

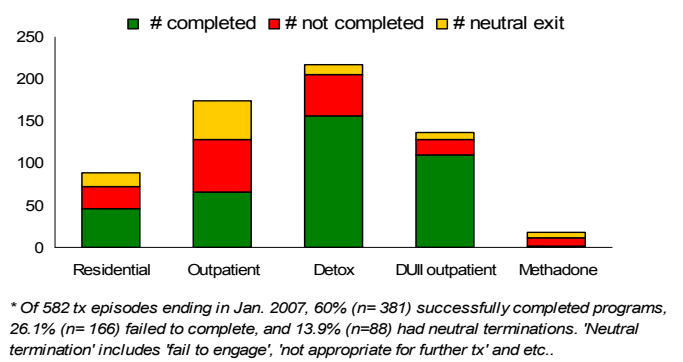
## Multnomah County Addictions Treatment



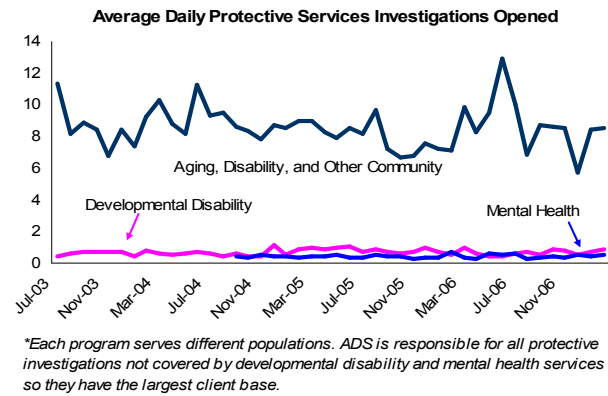
### Client or Service Type: February 2007



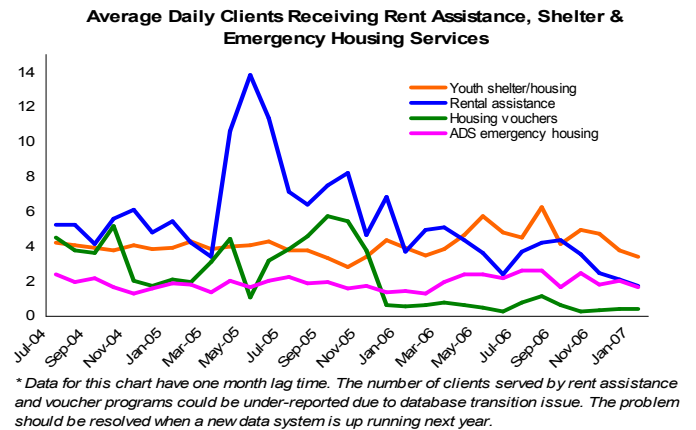
### A&D Treatment Exit Type by Modality: Jan. 2007



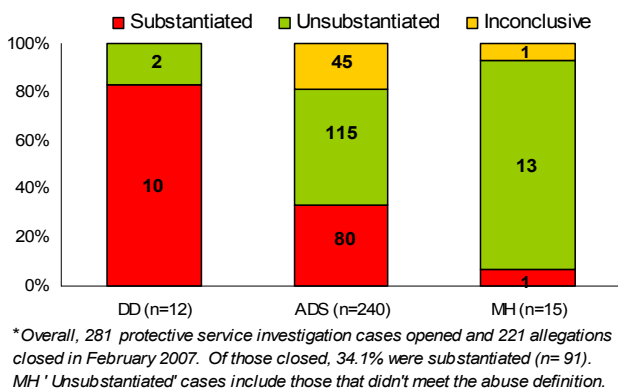

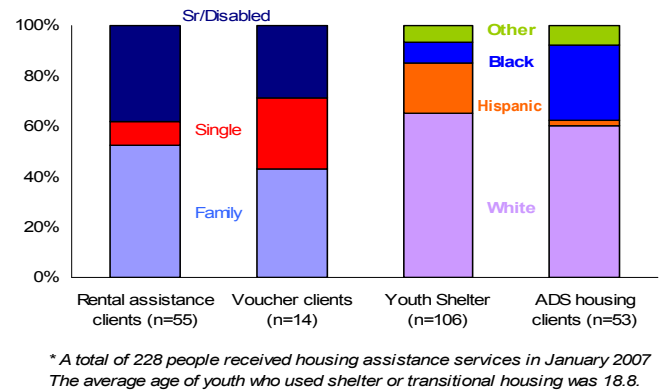
