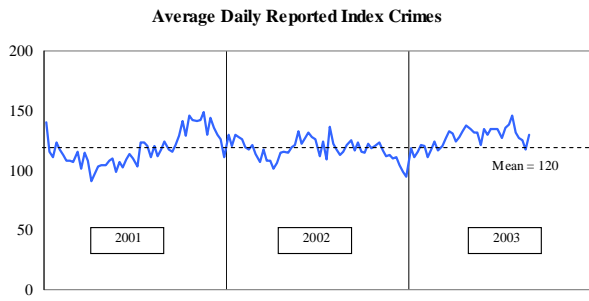


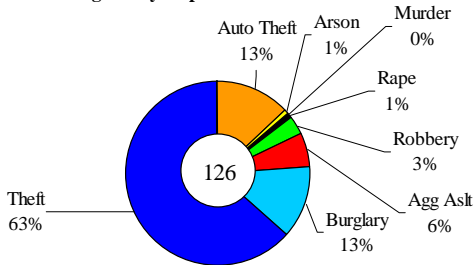

Portland Police: Reported Offenses



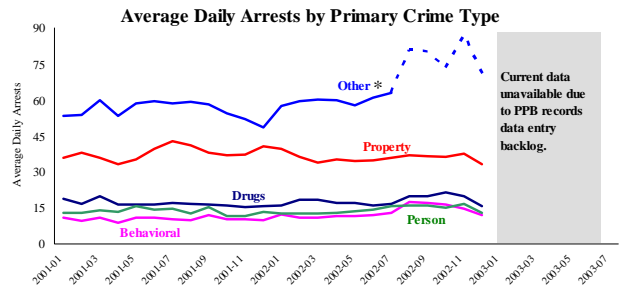
*PPB weekly index offense reports for week ending 8-30-03. Index crimes account for half of all crime.

Average Daily Reported Index Offenses*



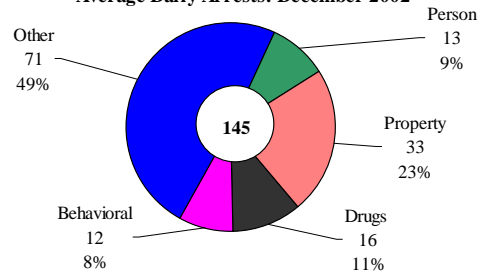
*City of Portland, 4-week moving average for week ending 8/30/2003

Multnomah County: Arrests (PPB, MCSO, & Fairview)



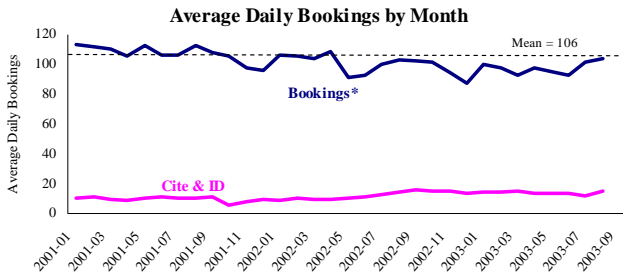

Average Daily Arrests: December 2002



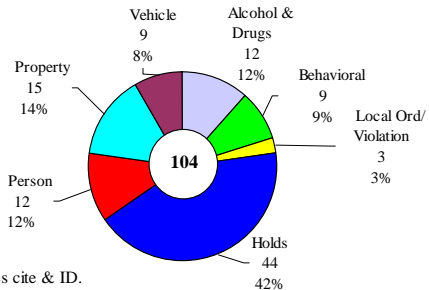

Sheriff: Bookings



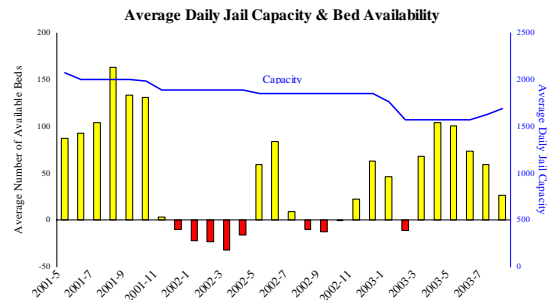

Average Daily Bookings*: August 2003



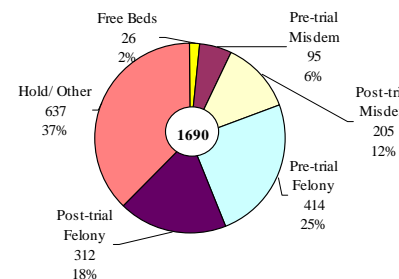

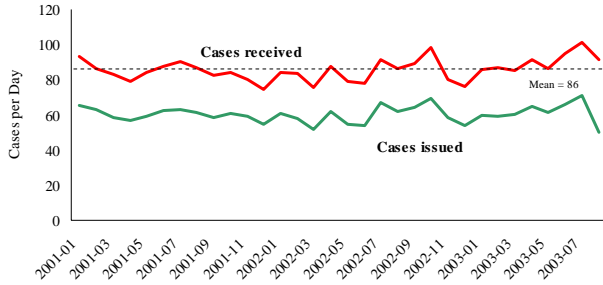
There has been a drop in the average daily index crime reports over the last four weeks; however the current moving average remains higher than the multi-year average.

The slight upward trend in the average daily number of bookings is driven by an overall increase in all types of felony bookings, with the exception of vehicle related felonies which dropped.

There was a 6% increase in the average daily inmate population along with the 4% increase in jail bed capacity.

DA Daily Caseload

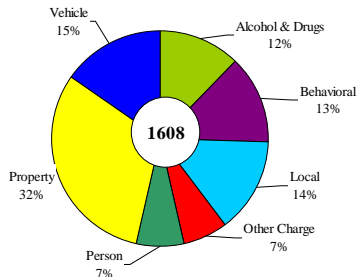

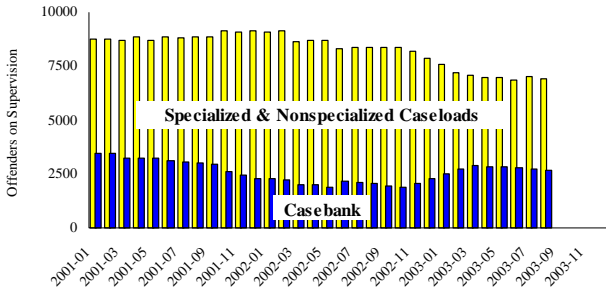

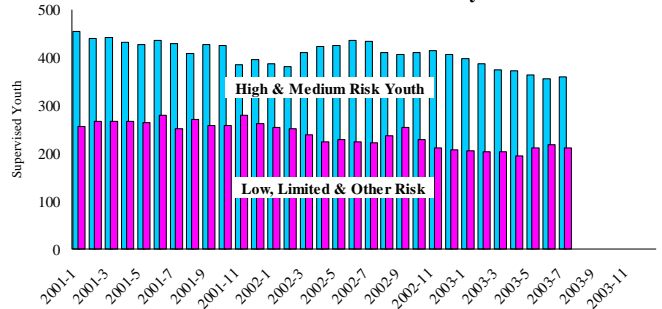
Active Adult Caseload



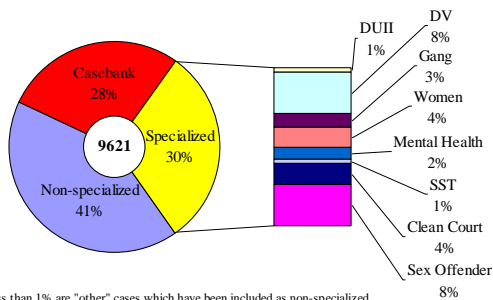

Juvenile Probation Caseload Trends by Risk

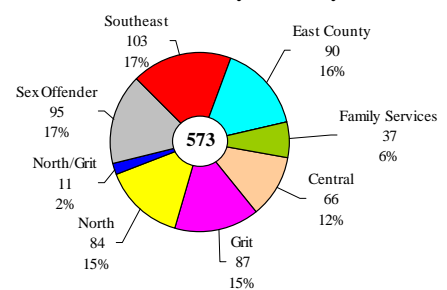


Adult Active Caseload by Type*: August 2003

Notes:

After reaching a high point in July 2003, daily cases received for review by the DA dropped to an average level. Adult supervision levels show a continued decline; the recent increase in medium and high-risk (i.e., non-casebank) cases that occurred in July dropped back down.

There has been a downward trend in the total number of juvenile caseloads over the past three years; this decline has been driven by a reduction in medium and low risk cases while the number of high risk cases (approximately 35% of all cases) has remained steady.
