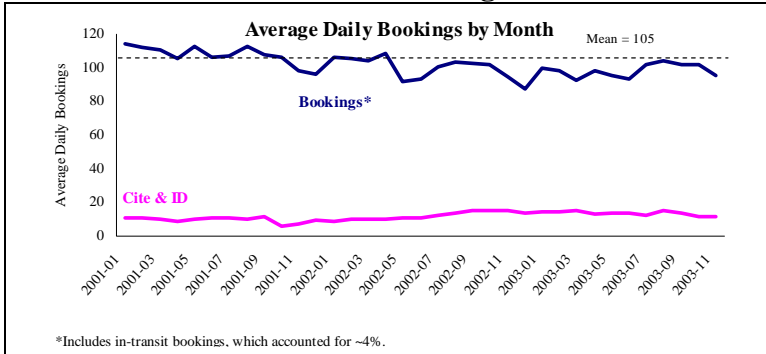
Portland Police: Reported Offenses



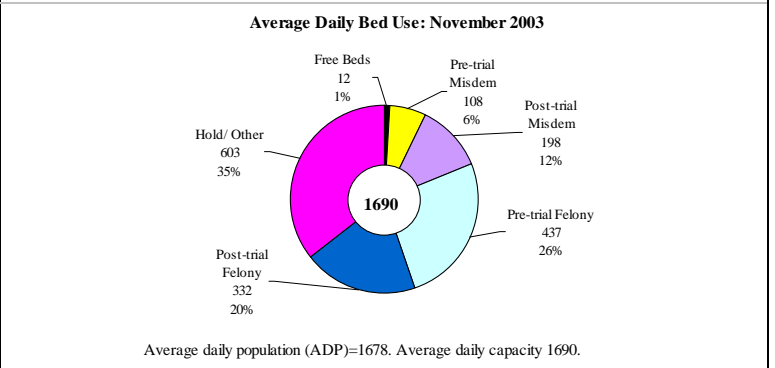
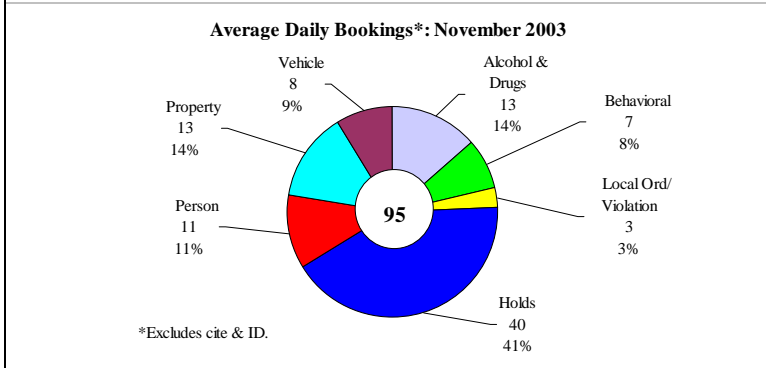
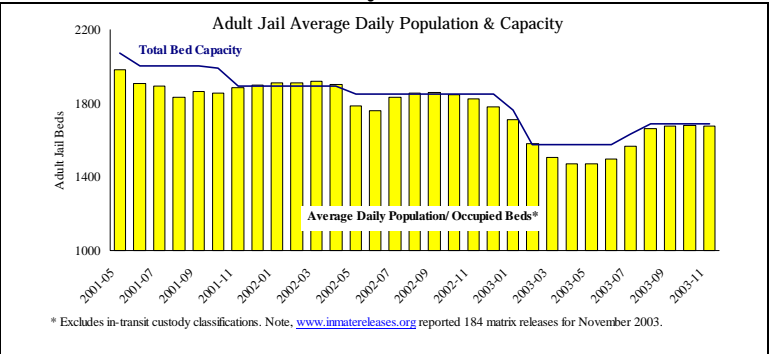
Multnomah County: Arrests (PPB, MCSO, & Fairview)



Sheriff: Bookings



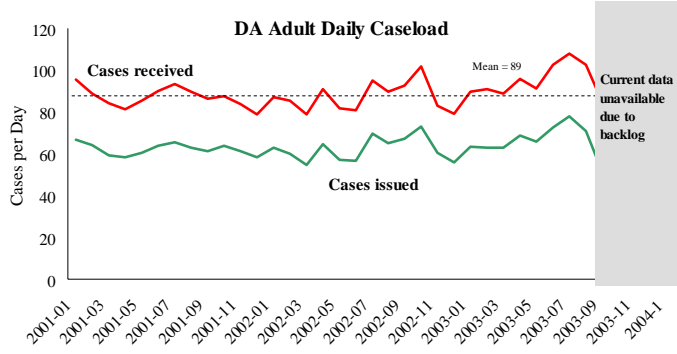
Sheriff: Custody- Adult Jail Beds

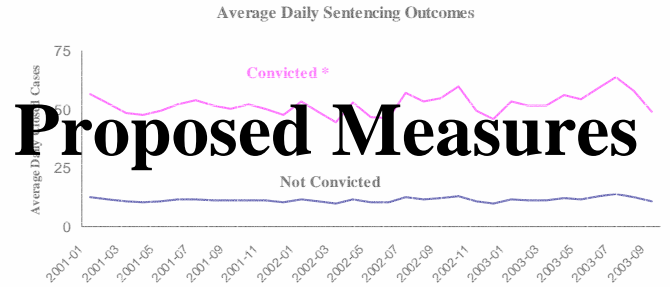
Compared to recent months, the daily average number of reported index crimes declined slightly. Arrest data has been amended; previous reports were based on data that included some arrests from jurisdictions outside of Multnomah County. There are no changes in arrest data to report. The average daily bookings dropped from 102 to 95, the largest decrease was in the average number of holds. There are no notable changes in custody data.

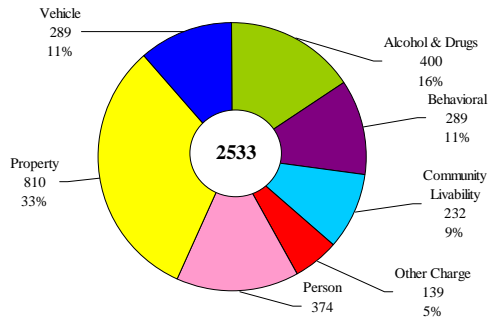
Court Processes: Sentencing Outcomes

Felony and misdemeanor outcomes only.

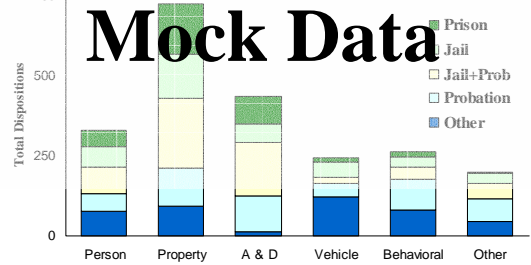

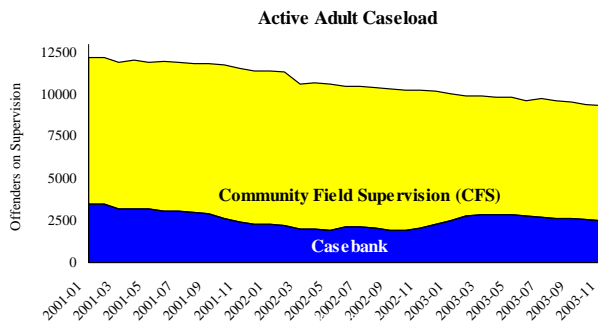

Dispositions Type by Primary Charges: Mock Data 2003

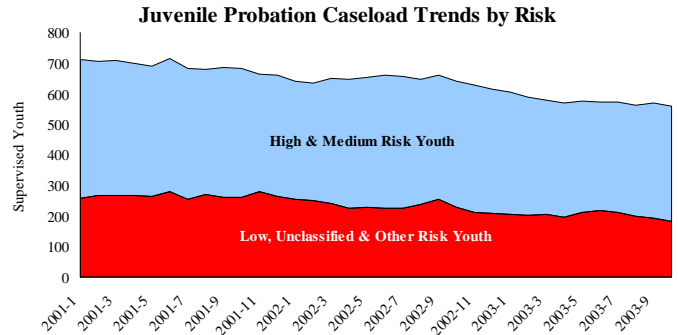


Adult Community Supervision: Caseloads



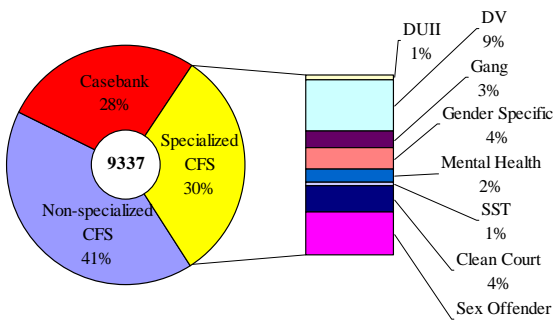

Juvenile Community Supervision: Caseloads



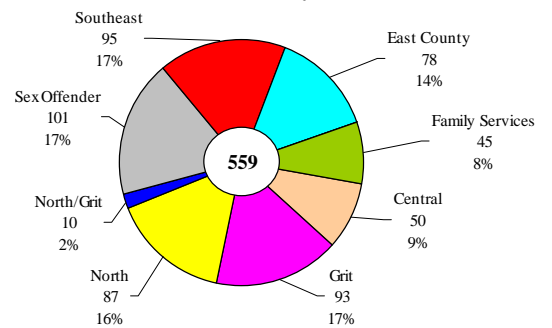
