




Multnomah County: Reported Index Offenses




*The graph reflects the combined weekly index offenses data from Portland Police Bureau (PPB) and Gresham Police Dept (GPD), beginning 8/2004 (line in blue). According to LEDS (2005) data PPB and GPD account for 95% of all offenses county-wide. Index offenses account for about half of all reported offenses.

Average Daily Reported Index Offenses*





Average Daily Arrests*: October (n=96)




Local charges include drug- and prostitution-free zone violations.

*There were 2980 arrests in October.


From now on, warrants previously categorized as 'other' will be listed under felony arrests.

Sheriff: Bookings




*In-transit bookinist are not reported herein and account for ~4% of all bookings. October's average length of stay (ALS) per booking was 17.61 days.

Average Daily Bookings by Severity*: October (n=95)





*Excludes in-transit custody classifications. The MCSO reported 0 matrix releases for October 2008.


Average Daily Bed Use: October (n=1474)




Average Daily Jail System Capacity=1539. Average Daily Population (ADP)=1474; there were 65 available beds on any given day.

Notes: Average Daily Reported Offenses has increased 16 incidents per day over the past two months to 118. The increase is due to a one week jump in Gresham of Auto Thefts as well as an increase in incidents of Residential Burglary and Larceny Auto in Portland. Average Daily Arrests continued a four month decline, decreasing another 2%, with Drug Arrests as being the only category to increase. Average Length of Stay and Average Daily Population increased for the second month in a row, ALS increased 8% and ADP to 1474, increasing the utilization rate to 95.7%, the highest since November of 2007.


District Attorney: Adult Caseload




Court Processes: Sentencing Outcomes




Average Daily Received Cases*: October (n=78)




Disposition Type by Primary Conviction*: October 2008




Adult Community Supervision: Caseloads




Juvenile Community Supervision: Caseloads

Notes: District Attorney Average Daily Received Cases, decreased 10% from September to October, to 78. Average Daily Adult Court Outcomes, Total Cases Closed and Convictions continue to rise for the third month in a row. Total Cases Closed for October rose to 258 and 205 of those were Convictions. Adult Active Caseload decreased from September to October. Juvenile Justice Caseload by Unit statistically did not change, however Average Caseload per counselor increased by 2%.
